



Checklist for your motorbike trip

Checklist motorcycle

- spare fuses
- replacement lamps
- complete tool kit
- general purpose tool (e.g., Leatherman)
- spare key (give it to your pillion rider)
- spare tension belt
- Lock (chain, bracket, brake disc lock ...)
- chain lubrication spray (if no chain oiler installed)
- puncture spray
- hand pump (for cases where puncture spray is not enough)
- LED headlamp or flashlight
- tape / fabric tape
- cable ties
- wire / rope / cord
- engine oil if special SAE requirements
- first aid kit (is it expired?)

Checkliste papers

- credit and / or debit card with PIN to draw money
- identity card / passport (give copies to pillion)
- driver's license
- vehicle registration certificate or registration certificate
- green insurance card (no longer mandatory in the EU, nevertheless recommended)
- power of attorney (if the driver and owner of the vehicle are not identical)
- AA membership cards
- list of telephone numbers for emergencies (e.g., embassy, ADAC roadside assistance)
- dictionary

Checklist for travel pharmacy

- suncream
- mosquito repellent
- plaster
- Mullbinde
- disinfectant
- painkillers
- medications you have to take regularly

Clothing driver (do not forget about usual clothing)

- rainsuit
- Rubber overgloves, rubber overshoes
- check helmet / visor
- scarf and balaclava
- sunglasses if you have no sun visor
- spare glasses / contact lenses / daily lenses (take enough)
- ear plugs against noise

Before the trip check / get

- expiration date of passport and credit card (passport must still be outside the EU at least be valid for six months)
- tire tread depth (does the tire last the whole travel distance?)
- condition of the chain
- carry out regular maintenance work such as changing the oil
- international health insurance
- powerbank for smartphone if no charging option on board
- good map material

And do not forget it

- smartphone
- install BikerSOS app
- start BikerSOS before the ride
